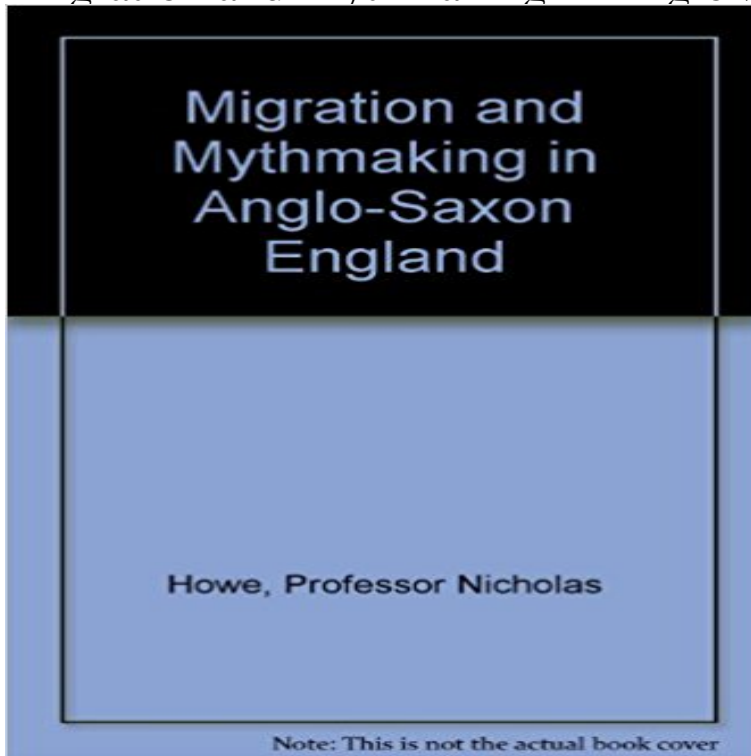


Migration and Mythmaking in Anglo-Saxon England
